WORD*Children's Message at Resurrection***FIRST READING: Isaiah 43:1-7**

- ¹But now thus says the LORD, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine.
- ²When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you.


SECOND READING: Acts 8:14-17
