### FIRST READING: Zechariah 9:9-12

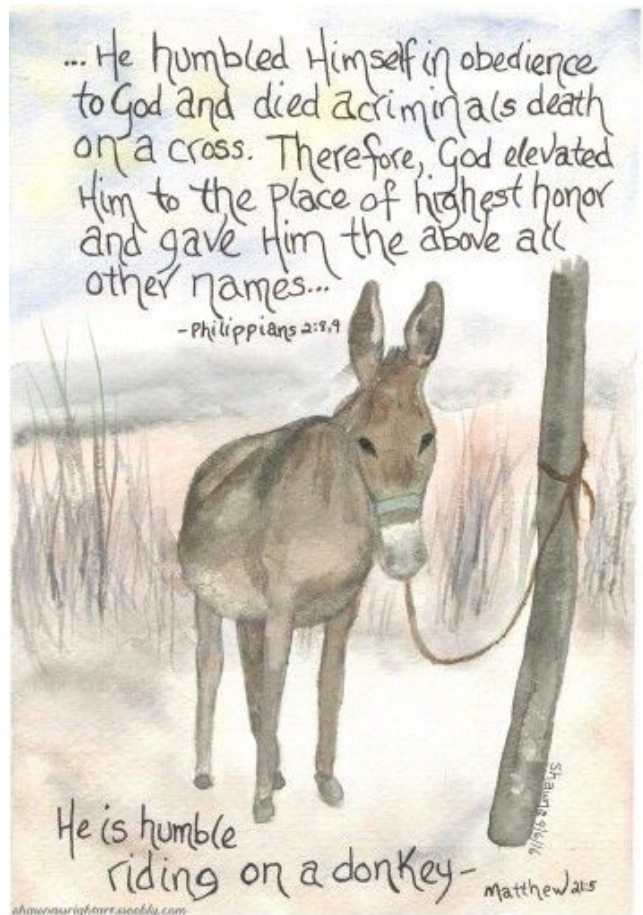
<sup>9</sup>Rejoice greatly, O daughter Zion!
